WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge has served with distinction as Librarian and Curator of Manuscripts and Archives of the Elizabeth M. MacDonell Memorial Library, of the Allen County Museum, for the past 43 years; and

WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge has worked tirelessly to promote the value of family and local history, through organizing, expanding and shaping the collections of the Elizabeth M. MacDonell Memorial Library; and

WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge has been a strong advocate of free and equal access to the library's resources as a cornerstone of civic pride, development, and stability; and

WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge has personally assisted over 100,000 patrons during her career including attorneys, civic leaders, government officials, representatives of the media, and every day citizens; and

WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge provided extensive and comprehensive materials for the weekly "Reminisce" column of The Lima News which reached thousands of readers annually; and

WHEREAS, Anna Selfridge served as editor of the Allen County Reporter, a publication of the Allen County Historical Society; **Now, Therefore,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIMA, OHIO, WITH AT LEAST A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That the Lima City Council hereby expresses its deepest appreciation and gratitude for Ms. Selfridge's contributions and wishes her well in all the years to come.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed upon adoption of this resolution to provide a copy to Anna Selfridge and the local news media.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of this Resolution to be made in a summary manner as provided by the City Charter.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members elected to council at the first reading hereof. If it shall not so pass it shall take effect and be in force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members elected to council at the second reading hereof. If it shall not so pass at second reading then it shall take effect and be in full force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of the members elected to council at the third reading hereof. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
